They just thought they were going to have to live with a dog with urinary issues the rest of their life and they felt they couldn't financially provide for her. Once I took her into my home 3 years ago and started her on Bravo she has NOT HAD ONE URINARY TRACT INFECTION!! I am sure you can understand my excitement!

I am a firm believer that diet plays a HUGE role in the health of an animal and I will never ever feed anything but Bravo Raw Foods.
