

ST. LUKE'S COFFEE HOUR

8:00am Service

Dan Dennis always arrives early and he will make coffee and set the cart up for that date's volunteer(s). Volunteer(s) might want to go to parish hall immediately after taking communion to move the cart outside the front doors of the church. After everyone has left, please take the cart back to the kitchen. In the event of inclement weather, plan on having coffee hour in narthex.

If Dan is out of town (he will let you know), you need to come a bit early on your morning and make the coffee and set up. This only takes about 20 minutes. You will need:

One pot of regular coffee, all found in kitchen

One pot of decaf coffee, all found in kitchen

Thermovacs, found in pantry – one regular and the decaf has orange on top

Sugar, creamer, etc., found in kitchen

Disposable coffee cups, found in pantry

Spoons to stir, in kitchen

Water or lemonade in a small pitcher, pitcher is in kitchen and lemonade is kept in the pantry

Bowl of animal crackers or goldfish, found in pantry

10:30am Service

After setting up these last few Sundays, we have found out that it is best to make the coffee prior to the service. When you are leaving for the service be sure hot plates are turned on under the coffee pots. Again, it is best to leave church immediately after you have had communion so you can complete set-up. Just refresh the cart, pour the coffee and push the cart to where you will be serving that day. Weather permitting; please move the cart to the front of the church. In the event of inclement weather, coffee hour will be in the parish hall. If Father Carey and Joanna want to change the location, they will give you plenty of preparation time.

*NOTE: Dan will leave the pantry door open for late service volunteer(s). If he is not at church and early service volunteer(s) does not have a key to the pantry, be sure to arrange to get one from the church office. Upon departure, please be sure to keep the pantry open for the next group.

If you are not familiar with the kitchen and want help your first time, please let Valerie, Sherry or Wanda know and one of them will assist you.

In the event you cannot be at church on your assigned Sunday, please call another volunteer to change dates.
