


## HARVESTFEST IS A RAIN OR SHINE EVENT!

#### **FREE PARKING:**

Public Parking for Harvestfest is at York's Wild Animal Kingdom. The parking meters at the beach are free during Harvestfest. Handicap Parking is available in the lot next to the Winebaum Center and the perimeter ball field road. (Access the handicap parking by going down Ridge Road, not the directions below.)



#### DIRECTIONS TO FREE PARKING AT THE YORK'S WILD ANIMAL KINGDOM:

**From the South on I-95:** Take I-95 North to Exit 7 (York exit). Bear right onto Spur Road. Go left at stoplight onto Route 1 North. Turn right at York's Wild Animal Kingdom. Follow the road down to the parking lot.

**From the South on Route 1:** Follow Route 1 North to York. Turn right at York's Wild Animal Kingdom. Follow the road down to the parking lot.

**From the North on I-95:** Take I-95 South to Exit 7 (York exit). Bear left onto Spur Road. Go left at stoplight onto Route 1 North. Turn right at York's Wild Animal Kingdom. Follow the road down to the parking lot.

From the North on Route 1: Follow Route 1 South to York. Pass the 1A intersection in Cape Neddick. Take left at York's Wild Animal Kingdom. Follow the road down to the parking lot.

## Harvestfest 2012

#### October 13 & 14, 2012 at York Beach

In its 28th year, Harvestfest is a two-day event located at beautiful Short Sands Beach, in York, Maine. Harvestfest is held every year on the weekend following the three-day Sidewalk Salefest event held Columbus Day weekend. Harvestfest extends the season one more week for many businesses in the area and aims to support the entire region and community. This year's event will have more than 150 local food vendors, Juried Crafters and the Old Fashioned Marketplace Crafters. Two days of family fun and entertainment, including live music performed by The Don Campbell Band and York's own Skyler! Hayrides, a petting zoo, Roaming Railroad, the Pow-Wow, and much more! Harvestfest is southern Maine's premiere fall festival. It will be celebrated this year on Saturday, Oct. 13 and Sunday, Oct. 14.

The Greater York Region Chamber of Commerce, which puts on Harvestfest, is pleased to announce the four presenting sponsors: Cutty Sark Motel, Kennebunk Savings, Union Bluff Hotel and Meeting House and Woods Family Inc. All four of the sponsors are key players in making Harvestfest happen, though much of their involvement remains behind the scenes. We enjoy the camaraderie and friendships that have developed over the years with the other volunteers and sponsors." Bank employees volunteer with many aspects of the event during the weekend; in particular, they sell coffee in partnership with Carpe Diem Coffee Roasters to raise money for the York Food Pantry on Saturday.
