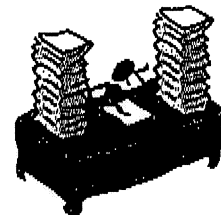

After reviewing your inquiry dated August 29, 2012, I researched and received a Letter from the IRS department of Exempt Organizations that states Air Force Association is exempt under Section 501 (c) (3). And under that they are 509 A (1) Public Charity.

I would like to explain that you can not see this as an Exempt Organization on the Exempt Org Master File (EOMF) due to the IRS had a system failure a while back and still they are working with their programmers to get the problem resolved. Once it is repaired it will take some time to load all the missing Organizations on to the master file. You can look on Select Check and see your Organization is listed there.



This is in response to your August 30, 2012, request for information about your tax-exempt status.


Our records indicate that you were issued a determination letter in September 2009, and that you are currently exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
