Agricultural Burn Permits For Agricultural Waste Burning

Agriculture burning is **allowed** in rural areas of San Luis Obispo County by PERMIT only.

Agricultural burning is open outdoor fires used in agricultural operations in the growing of crops or raising of fowl or animals, used in vegetation management, forest management, range improvement, the improvement of land for wildlife and game habitat, or disease or pest prevention. Income is derived solely or partially from agricultural practices on property where the burn is located; a Farmers' Market Certificate will also be sufficient proof of agricultural income.

How to Receive a Permit:

- 1) Fill out application located in the box
- 2) Enclose \$50.00 permit fee with the SLOAPCD copy of the application
- 3) Mail application and fee using postage paid envelope to:

4) Your application serves as a permit, effective when fees are received. If your application is denied, the SLOAPCD will contact you immediately.
