On past trips we have seen whales, seals, schooling tuna, and gorgeous sunsets. Our clients are encouraged to take the helm if they wish or just sit and relax.

As we reach the Isle of Shoals we anchor or grab a mooring in Goffsport harbor. We usually take the dingy to Smutty Nose or Star Island to picnic and explore. This is a nice take especially for those who have never been.

The Isle of shoals was once a fishing village of 400 families. It was a rough place to live, home to pirates and to the loyalist of England . During the revolution , these people were forced back to the mainland giving the new government more control of the area.


Star Island is the home of a retreat center for the Unitarian and Congregation churches. Visitors have

plenty of photo opportunities, and are welcome to visit their museum when open.

This is a nice trip and affordably priced at \$450 for a family of four. Each additional person up to six cost \$50.

On the trip to Rockport, we explore Bearskin Neck. A tourists may get a bite to eat at Ellen's restaurant or an ice cream along the road.
