NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD and PUBLIC OPEN HOUSES FOR THE FOLLOWING MAJOR REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ACTIONS:

- **♦ DRAFT 2040 COMPREHENSIVE REGIONAL PLAN**
- **♦ THE FY 2012-2015 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)**
- ◆ THE AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY DETERMINATION

The Northwestern Indiana Regional Planning Commission (NIRPC) will provide a 30-day public comment period and conduct public open houses related to the approval and adoption of the above listed regional transportation planning actions. Subject to action by the NIRPC Board, the public comment period will begin April 28, 2011, with the release of the draft 2040 Plan, the Fiscal Year 2012-2015 TIP, and the Conformity Determination report. The Draft 2040 Comprehensive Regional Plan is the first long-range comprehensive regional plan for Lake, Porter and La Porte Counties. The draft plan is based on a regional vision created through public participation that started with the regional forum on December 6, 2008 and continued through 2010 with a series of six workshops and numerous public meetings throughout Lake, Porter and LaPorte Counties. From this beginning a draft vision statement and draft goals and objectives were developed, followed by regional policies and strategies to achieve the vision and goals. The draft comprehensive regional plan addresses transportation, economic development, land use, the environment, and social equity. The Draft Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is a regional program of federally funded state and local highway and transit projects prioritized over a four-year period. Highway capacity-increasing projects in a TIP must come from a conforming long-range regional plan. Transportation projects will be selected for funding under the federal fund categories for highway, public transit, bridge inspection program, railroad crossings, congestion mitigation and air quality (CMAQ), local demonstration projects and Indiana Department of Transportation highway projects.

<u>The Draft Air Quality Conformity Determination</u> establishes the compatibility between the state air quality implementation plan and the proposed amended long-range regional transportation plan and the TIP. The conformity determination assures that the transportation projects in the TIP will not contribute to more air pollution.

The Adoption

The 2040 Plan, the TIP, and the air quality conformity determination will be finalized based upon public input and presented for adoption by NIRPC's Board of

Commissioners on June 23, 2011 at the 9:00 a.m. meeting at NIRPC. NIRPC meetings are open to the public and the agenda provides for public comments.
