Registration Policy and Fee

Registration begins June 12, 2012. Registrations will be accepted by mail. Enrollment is limited so registrations will be stamped with the date of receipt and processed on a first come first served basis. Registration must include payment for 50% of the total course fee. The fee for each course is \$175 for CMMC members and \$200 for non-members. The course fee includes a \$50 enrollment fee per session per child which in non-refundable.

Payment Deadline

Refund and Cancellation Policy
