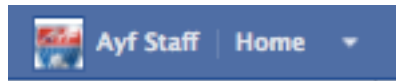
also send e-mails to all of those who are a part of your group – which makes communication efficient.

Pages:

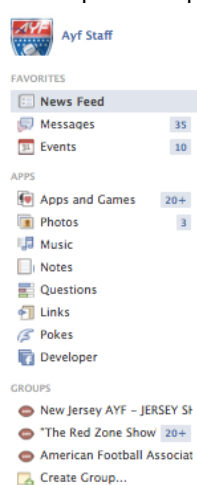

Making a Group On Facebook

1. Log into your “Facebook profile”
2. Go to this link: <http://www.facebook.com/about/groups>
3. Click on the “Home” Button on the top right of the page
