A VISIT TO BRANDYWINE NOVEMBER 3-4, 2013

Join us for our excursion to the Brandywine Valley in early November. On Sunday we will visit the historic town of Newcastle, Delaware, established in 1651. There will be several hours in the afternoon to stroll the bricked sidewalks, explore shops or visit one of the historic buildings—it's your choice. Many of the sites have free admission. Visit www.newcastlehistory.org. Sunday evening we will stay at the prestigious Hotel Du Pont in downtown Wilmington. On Monday, immerse yourself in a study of the famous Wyeth artists, N.C., Andrew, and Jamie. We will visit their studios, the Kuerner Farm and the Brandywine River Museum. This former 19th century grist mill houses an unparalleled collection by the 3 generations of Wyeths and other noted still life and landscape artists. A special exhibition, "Jamie Wyeth, Rockwell Kent and Mohegan" will be available for viewing as well. The cost per person is \$395 for members; \$445 for nonmembers. This includes deluxe motor coach transportation, driver gratuity, hotel accommodation, full breakfast, all Wyeth museum admissions, and lunch at the Brandywine River Museum. This price is based on double occupancy. For single supplement add \$85. Group size is limited to 28. Payment with reservation form is due no later than September 1.
