

Carolyn's Supply List:

Bring what you have - any waterbased paint, except watercolors

Bring paints you never use - we will use them!

I go to Home Depot and Lowe's for about everything I use.

I use latex (house paint) for first few layers, then "tweak, finish out" with Golden, Holbein and Nova, etc.

Black permanent pens (no Sharpies regardless of what it says)

Oil paintsticks or oil pastels. Shiva makes "Artist Paintstick" dries in 24 hours.

Large water bucket

Dropcloth for tables

Large and some small paintbrushes. The cheaper the better.

Big palette knives

Brayers

Squeegee

Latex gloves

Rubbing alcohol

Rags

Polymer varnish water based (Minwax polycrylic) Home Depot or Walmart

Collage material and gel medium

Gallery wrap canvases, Either 1-1/2 or 2 inch deep.

For canvases and paints, I use jerrysartarama.com, or asw.com. They come 3 to a box.

I would suggest that 30x30 be the smallest size as we are going to be loosening up and that's hard to do on small surfaces!

I use heavy texture - Venetian plaster (Home Depot) I will bring a gallon to get started.

These are all suggestions - canvas and some house paint to start is all you need. I will have plenty of things to use.
