Accessing the Combined Proceedings Online: A Primer

One of the benefits of membership in the IPPS Eastern Region is the ability to view abstracts and obtain papers from past Combined Proceedings that are posted online. The IPPS Combined Proceedings include papers presented at the conferences held annually in each of the 8 IPPS regions around the world. The plant production and propagation topics are as varied as are the regions: Eastern, Western and Southern in North America; Great Britain and Ireland, Southern Africa, New Zealand, Australia and the Region of Japan. The Proceedings are hosted online by the International Society of Horticultural Science's (ISHS) PubHort website.

When you click on this link, (<u>CLICK HERE</u>) you are directed to a page of the International IPPS website where you can view a list of volumes 1-60 of the Combined Proceedings (1951-2010). If you click on a particular volume, you can then see all of the paper titles and authors listed, each with a link to see the abstract for that paper. Looking for a specific plant or topic? You can search all volumes or a particular volume with either a simple one word search or via a more advanced search.

If you read a specific abstract and want the full text pdf file of the paper, you simply click on "Full text – IPPS members". **Note that you can view the abstract as well as the full paper in any one of 66 (that's sixty-six) different languages!** Viewing titles and reading abstracts is open to everyone. However if you want to download an entire paper, you will be asked to log in.

The log-in protocol allows the system to verify that you are an IPPS member and entitled to article downloads. First enter your e-mail address – this must be the e-mail address that is associated with your IPPS Eastern Region membership in order for the system to recognize it. You also need to enter a password. If you have not already set a password, just click the bottom box where it says "I do not have a password, or I forgot my password, please mail the password to me." Then click on Login. You will receive your password within minutes; you later have the option to change it to one of your own choosing.

Used up all 10 of your downloads? You can either pay to download additional articles or perhaps you can find a fellow IPPS member who may be willing to share a download with you!

Please note that the above procedure for accessing the Proceedings downloads is not the same as the log-in procedure to the Member Area of the IPPS International website where you can view all IPPS regional membership directories and information about the IPPS LinkedIn group. The user name and password for the Member Area was e-mailed to you by the IPPS-Eastern Region office. New members receive this information in their welcome letter. This user name and password change periodically for security reasons. Please note that they are case sensitive and must be entered exactly as received. Can't find it?
