All IPPS members can now view all the abstracts for every paper presented in 56 years of IPPS Proceedings! And IPPS Option 1 members (who paid for the proceedings) will also be able to download up to ten (10) full papers with no charge through the rest of this year. Your membership renewal in 2011 entitles you to download ten more papers for every year you keep your Option 1 membership. At this time, because Option 2 members have not paid to receive the Proceedings, they will not be able to download the full papers at no charge.

Here's how:

Go to www.ipps.org

Click on "Proceedings" tab on the menu bar at the top

Then on "Proceedings on PubHort website."

- Click on a volume of the Proceedings. Click on an abstract title that interests you. At the bottom of the abstract text, you will see two links to the full paper.
- Click on the IPPS Members link and you'll go to a login screen that asks for your Email or Subscription number.
- Type in the email address you use for your IPPS membership.
- Since you have not yet received your password, click on the box below that asks for your password to be emailed to you.
- Click on "Login" and then check your email for the unique password that belongs to you.
- When received, type in that password (THIS PASSWORD IS CASE-SENSITIVE, SO TYPE IT EXACTLY AS IT APPEARS IN THE EMAIL YOU RECEIVE) and you'll go to a screen asking if you want to download the full paper of the abstract you selected. You can now click on that link for your download.
- You will also find a link after you log in called "IPPS User Maintenance" this link shows you your personal account information. In this particular box, you can change your password if you like.

All the papers from the past Combined Proceedings have been published on the PubHort website operated by the International Society for Horticultural Science (ISHS) - over 32,000 pages of IPPS knowledge from all those years! Our partnership with ISHS allows us to have abstracts from all the papers through Volume 56 available for viewing by anyone in the world for an additional fee.

The International Board of Directors brings this new IPPS member service to you. Not only will our members benefit from being published (each volume will continue to be added to the PubHort site), but IPPS will also have more visibility in the international community of those who have an interest in plants and their production. Visit the ISHS site and look at the other organizations who have added their papers to the collection of knowledge being gathered on this website. This is a major step forward for IPPS – both in service to our members and in sharing our knowledge worldwide.
