MRTA LEGISLATIVE DAY FEBRUARY 14, 2012 ISSUES OF IMPORTANCE 2012 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

- #1) MRTA STRONGLY OPPOSES THE CONCEPT OF A STATE INVESTMENT BOARD/COMPANY AS HAS BEEN PROPOSED IN THE PAST BY SENATOR JASON CROWELL.
- #2) MRTA OPPOSES ANY LEGISLATION THAT PUTS NEWLY HIRED EDUCATORS INTO A PRIVATE RETIREMENT PLAN (401 K) OR INTO A NEW TIER SYSTEM THAT REDUCES EDUCATOR RETIREMENT BENEFITS. THE PSRS/PEERS SYSTEM IS STRONG AND 85% FUNDED. NO HELP NEEDED.
- #3) MRTA Supports full Funding of K-12 public education as the Missouri Constitution Mandates through HB 2, the second priority of state expenditures.
- #4) MRTA STRONGLY OPPOSES SB 706 CUNNINGHAM, PRIORITY! STATE TAX DOLLARS DIRECTED TO PRIVATE SCHOOLS THROUGH VOUCHERS OR SCHOLARSHIPS. SB 706 HAS BECOME THE CHRISTMAS TREE OF LEGISLATION THAT MRTA OPPOSES.
- #5) MRTA OPPOSES HB 1228 (REPS. JONES & COOKSON) AND SB 576 (SEN. STOUFFER) THE EXPANSION OF CHARTER SCHOOLS WITH NO ACCOUNTABILITY.
- #6 MRTA OPPOSES THE CONCEPT OF TABOR (SPENDING CAPS) HJR 43 (REP. BURLISON) AS THIS WILL HURT PUBLIC EDUCATION FUNDING.
- #7) MRTA OPPOSES HB 1526 (REP DIECKHAUS). THIS BILL ELIMINATES TEACHER TENURE.
- #8) MRTA SUPPORTS AND WILL PROTECT THE PENSION BENEFITS OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL RETIREMENT SYSTEMS OF KANSAS CITY AND SAINT LOUIS CITY.
