Our goal is to empower and encourage clients to achieve financial self-sufficiency.

In 2012, WFCM served 3,272 people with food, clothing, rent and utility assistance. We rely on financial support from businesses, churches, schools and individuals to support our programs.

- Over 62,000 people live below poverty level in Fairfax County
- 1 in 6 children go to school hungry in Northern Virginia
- Over 69,000 Fairfax County residents are a risk of experiencing hunger.
- 1,350 people are homeless in the Fairfax-Falls Church community; children in families accounted for one third (452)
- 24 percent of households in Northern Virginia do not earn enough to meet basic monthly expenditures such as food, housing, and transportation.
