RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has recognized the need for better implementation of enforcement of federal laws on immigration; and

WHEREAS, Arizona Governor Jan Brewer has recognized her responsibility to the citizens of Arizona regarding the important issues of foreign immigration into the State of Arizona and the protection of the lawful citizens of Arizona, by signing into law on April 23, 2010, Arizona SB 1070 the "Support Our Law Enforcement and Safe Neighborhoods Act," sponsored by Arizona State Sen. Russell Pearce; and

WHEREAS, United States Senator John Kyl (AZ) has stated his interest in studying the law as it applies to the current "anchor child" provisions of the 14th Amendment to the United States Constitution.

RESOLVED, that the Texas Federation of Republican Women, at its Board of Directors meeting in Austin, Texas, on August 6, 2010, commends the State of Arizona, its Governor the Honorable Jan Brewer, its State Senator Russell Pearce, and its United States Senator the Honorable John Kyl for their efforts to enforce federal law as it relates to foreign immigration.
