

NOW OPEN, PFC EAST!

PFC is proud to announce the opening of a new satellite office in the Washington, D.C. metro area. In an effort to be more accessible to U.S. Government clients, PFC Training will now manage an office and offer courses at the Protective Services Training Academy (PSTA) near Andrews Air Force Base, Maryland.

This East Coast hub for PFC is located in Prince Georges County and is approximately 11 miles from the United States Capitol. The training center offers over 40,000 square feet of work space under one roof and was built from the ground up with state of the art ranges, classrooms, multi-purpose areas, a pro shop, etc.

The PSTA is the newest and most modern training facility in the Washington, D.C. region. The large indoor square ranges can be programmed to shoot a variety of courses of fire for qualification purposes, or training can be run in front of the lanes for movement drills. The location has upgraded classroom facilities that include an array of instructor training aids including Internet connection and overhead projectors for power point and video teaching. There is a dedicated combatives training area and additional open space inside the complex to conduct specialized training such as team tactics, vehicle drills and protective detail exercises.

PFC conducted its first DC Metro Area PSOC training in November 2012, which was a great success. Additional training planned for 2013 include another PSOC course, PFC's Combative Pistol Instructor Certification (CPIC), and PFC's Code 4 Tactics Instructor Certification (C4T-IC). Both instructor development courses are 4-day programs and currently in the process of being added to PFC's GSA-approved list of course offerings.

We look forward to being a significant resource and professional training model in the Washington, D.C. metro area. PFC's aim is to provide government agencies and private companies in the Capitol Region with the most cutting-edge use of force and tactics training available anywhere in the U.S. Now, this training just happens to be closer and more convenient than ever.
