Chris Enfinger is a police officer with a major metropolitan police agency and a service member with the United States Air Force. He is a seasoned weapons and tactics instructor with over 15 years of military and civilian law enforcement experience.

Chris began his professional career with the United States Air Force. Quickly recognized for his proficiency and skill-at-arms, Chris was assigned to a training squadron where he ultimately mastered all technical and tactical aspects of twenty different weapons systems. During his time with the training unit, he also developed and implemented tactical shooting courses of fire for the entire battery of Air Force Small Arms encompassing eight different weapons systems. Chris then went on to train specialized weapons and tactics teams (SWAT) in advanced combat and warfare doctrine. Chris' ability as an instructor and his subject matter expertise secured him an adjunct instructor position with the Community College of the Air Force for three years. Chris was then asked to be part of the cadre instructing the Air Force Combat Arms Apprentice Course, teaching others to become weapons and tactics instructors for the United States Air Force at the Security Forces Headquarters at Lackland Air Force Base in San Antonio, Texas.

Ever the professional student, in addition to countless hours in weapons and tactics training, Chris has continued his personal and professional development earning two Associates Degrees (Technology and Military Science & Criminal Justice), a Bachelor's Degree in Education with a Specialization in Training Methodology, and ultimately attaining a Masters of Science Degree in Education with a Teaching Certificate.

Chris is currently a Police Officer with the San Antonio Police Department and Staff Instructor with Progressive F.O.R.C.E. Concepts (PFC). As a member of the PFC team, his responsibilities include weapons and tactics instruction to military, law enforcement and government personnel.
