Thank you for answering God's call into the music ministry! We want to make sure that you feel this ministry is for you, as well as find a right fit for your talents. Please understand that not everyone will be suited for the Sunday Morning Worship Band, but there are many rooms in the music ministry house. Special services such as Christmas Eve, Holy Thursday, and Easter Sunday, as well as special music will warrant more participation and may be a better fit for some people. This team exists not as a platform for performing, but as an altar proclaiming God's word to the congregation in the form of music. The audition process will be designed to be non-threatening; however, you will possibly be expected to either sing or play in front of the entire group. This is done to not only give you a chance to shine, but also for me to discern how you can best serve in this ministry.

I've included three songs within this packet for you to rehearse for the audition. There is one up tempo song that everyone must know, and 2 slow tempo/ballad songs that are gender specific. If you are an instrumentalist only (non-singer), please be prepared to play all three selections. Please note that the charts do not include music notes, but rather chord progressions. As of now, we predominately play by ear; however, there will be times when music is played by reading the notes. To be successful in this band, one must be able to hear and learn a song, but we greatly welcome those who can read music as well! I recommend searching for these songs on "Youtube," so that you can listen and rehearse before the audition.
