Girl Scout's Health Lodge Gets Facelift in Honor of Local Woman

The Girl Scouts' Comstock Program Center has a renovated health/troop lodge thanks to the generous donation of George and Sheila Moy Saul. The Sauls, now residents of Washington State, made the donation in honor of Sheila's mother Mrs. Peg Moy, a resident of Ithaca.

Sheila Saul remembers fondly her summers camping at Comstock, even pointing out to current staff which cabin she stayed in. The donation to renovate the lodge will allow the camp to once again be used for resident camping, and also give Girl Scout troops another option for overnights.

The renovation included knotty pine wood in the interior walls and ceiling, making the lodge and bathroom handicap accessible to ADA standards, replacing the front porch and adding a handicap ramp, replacing some of the outside siding, new electric and plumbing and adding a new wood stove. The stove and the new windows, and insulation will extend the camping season for the girls.

Girl Scouts of NYPENN Pathways is conducting three weeks of resident camp this summer and already 285 girls have registered to attend. Girls don't have to be members to attend.
