

The **SUMMER STAFF** is made up of college-age adults who are committed to serving God by ministering to the youth of The Falls Church. Summer staff applicants must have completed their freshman year of college (or be age equivalent) to qualify. Special exceptions may be made by the Director of Youth Ministries.

The position of summer staff is **NOT** an elevated position, but one of humility and service that focuses of glorifying God and loving others. As you prayerfully consider a ministry position at The Falls Church Anglican, understand that responsibilities and expectations will be high. This is a full-time job, and you will be held accountable.

Being on Summer Staff is a full-time commitment starting **Monday, June 10th, 2013**, at 8:30 am, and **ending Monday, August 12th**, at 5:00 pm. You will receive a total stipend of **\$2,000** for the summer. Decisions on applicants are based upon this completed application (including, ministry reference and peer reference). We reserve the right to terminate your position at any time for any unbiblical conduct, safety reasons, or leadership detrimental to the body of Christ.
