2013 Ticket Policy for Access to CN Canadian Women's Open and RBC Canadian Open Championships

Golf Canada is pleased permit all card carrying members of the CGSA complimentary grounds access to the RBC Canadian Open and the CN Canadian Women's Open in 2013.

Members are required to sign in at the admissions booth, present a current membership card and photo ID and upon presentation they will be provided with a daily pass for themselves and for their guest.

Please note, if the tournament day is in a sell-out position, only the card carrying member will be allowed access free of charge.

This year's RBC Canadian Open will be played at Glen Abbey Golf Club, Oakville, ON, July 22-28th. Members attending should park in the general spectator lots, locations to be available at www.rbccanadianopen.com. Tournament shuttle buses will transport you to the main spectator gate.

This year's CN Canadian Women's Open will be played at Royal Mayfair Golf Club, Edmonton, AB, August 19- 25th. Members attending should park in the general spectator lots, locations to be available at www.cncanadianwomensopen.com. Tournament shuttle buses will transport you to the main spectator gate

Ground Access – United States Golf Association (USGA) - All 2013 USGA Championship

Complimentary grounds admission to all USGA Championships is available to CGSA Gold card members. The spouse or guest of the CGSA Member is also granted complimentary admission to the Women's Open, Senior Open and U.S. Amateur; however; the spouse or guest is NOT granted complimentary admission to the U.S. Open.

Members are to park at the general parking at each Championship and take the complimentary shuttle to the Will Call facility.

You will need to show both a valid CGSA membership card and a photo identification card to receive a complimentary admission grounds ticket. The

same procedure applies for each day of the Championships that the member wishes to attend.
