Course Title: Basic Medicolegal Death Investigations RESTRICTED

**Course Description:** This basic forensic and medicolegal program will discuss Pennsylvania State Statutes and what constitutes a Coroner's death investigation, determining time of death, cause and manner of death, the importance of forensic autopsies and the preservation of evidence in an investigation.

This course was developed for the 1st Responder, who upon arriving on a scene determines that a death has occurred. The 1<sup>st</sup> Responder can be the Paramedic/EMS, Law Enforcement Officer, Fire Fighter or Fire Investigator. The 1<sup>st</sup> Responder will be instructed on the importance of preserving the scene and evidence surrounding the body.

Other lecture topics will be on the issuance of the Coroner's Subpoena, HIPAA regulations, the proper techniques of making positive identification of a deceased individual, and the importance of Forensic Autopsies and the preservation of evidence in a death Investigation. This course has been approved for eight (8) hours of continuing education by the Pennsylvania Coroners' Education Board under the provisions of Act 22 of 1988.

Due to the subject matter and sensitivity of this training, all attendees must be in-service professionals.
