The Emergency Medical Technician Basic course is an intensive for individuals looking for a career in emergency medicine. This skills oriented course, features extensive hands-on instruction in the evaluation and treatment of the sick and injured; fundamental training required for emergency services medical personnel; CPR, preparatory, airway, patient assessment, traumatic injuries, fractures, thoracic injuries, patient immobilization and lifting.

Course Structure

The course consists of clinical, lecture and testing. There is no absenteeism allowed for the duration of the course.
