The 3-day Pediatric course is offered as a combination course *or may* be taken by only previously trained SANE-Adult/Adolescent RN's.

Each Participant will receive in-depth orientation to the physical, emotional and social reactions to rape and sexual assault across the lifespan. In addition, each participant will have the opportunity to perform a standard evidentiary physical evaluation and examination.
