

Crime Scene Initial Response - Expanded

Tuesday, July 21, 2012 • 8am-5pm

Course Description: Theory and practices in the Initial Response to a Crime Scene is to include “real life experiences”. Upon the completion of this course, participants will be able to relate the application of procedures and responsibilities of assorted Units, Agencies, and Bureaus conducting the investigation. These topics include: the initial response to the scene; securing the scene; access control; communications; identify witnesses, briefing of arriving personnel; documentation. This course is ideal for new First Responder and new supervisor.

The participant will have two short group practical lab exercises and one group presentation. A written test will conclude the course and evaluate what they have learned. Participants should expect some graphic images in the course presentation.

Requirements: Please bring a camera, flashlight and dress appropriately – you will most likely get a little dirty.

Hours: 7 total hours; 4 lecture & 3 lab with a one hour lunch break. Meals are not provided.

Location: This program will be held at the Northeast Forensic Training Center located at the Fowler Family Southside Center in Bethlehem.

Credentials: This course has been approved for seven (7) hours of continuing education by the Pennsylvania Coroners’ Education Board under the provisions of Act 22 of 1988. We urge those who wish to have courses approved for credit by the Coroners’ Education Board to please allow a minimum of three months for processing.

Fee: Response organizations in Northampton County who are enrolled in the 2011 Emergency Services Subscription Program are eligible to participate in the course at no cost. This service is made possible through a grant from Northampton County Emergency Management Services. The fee for all other agencies is \$60.
