

YOUTH MINISTER WANTED

Fredericksburg Presbyterian Church

Description: Fredericksburg Presbyterian Church is dedicated to prayer, reaching out and growing people in the faith through loving relationships. We are a warm, welcoming and growing group of people. Our Sunday service is traditional but casual with an average attendance of 110. Our church building is located in Fredericksburg, OH, a town of about 500 people in the geographic center of Ohio Amish Country.

Position: Youth Minister

Time Requirements: Presently a part-time position requiring 10 to 15 hours per week. Work hours would include Sunday mornings from 9 am to noon and Sunday evenings when YDOC (Young Discoverers of Christ) is scheduled (typically three times a month). Other hours will be scheduled as necessary. Extended hours and overnight trips will be required for special events. Hours beyond 15 per week must be prior approved by the Pastor.

Terms:

- Hourly wage of \$12.50 per hour for the first 90 days with pay increasing to \$15 per hour after 90 days contingent upon a favorable personnel evaluation.
- Standard Workman's Compensation Insurance is provided
- Paid vacation, personal and holiday leave
- Supervised by the Pastor

General Purpose: Guide youth (grades 7-12) into deepening faith and lasting connections with Christ's church.

Personal Characteristics:

- A person of deepening faith, growing in his/her relationship with God through Prayer, Bible Study, and other traditional Christian disciplines
- Passion for a calling to ministry with and to youth
- Integrity, Self-motivated, self-directed
- Lifestyle consistent with that of a follower of Christ
- Good communication, interpersonal and organizational skills
- Able to develop and maintain a position of authority and respect with youth and youth ministry volunteers

Qualifications:

- Ability to lead and relate to youth and adult Youth Ministry Team volunteers
- General computer experience and knowledge necessary including word processing, desktop publishing, e-mail, internet skills and social networking media.
- Ability to take the initiative in situations as needed.
- Desire to continue to grow and learn in ability to minister with and to youth

Specific Responsibilities:

- Provide leadership and vision to the youth ministry of the church
- Act as a guide and support for the Youth Ministry Team
- Work with the Pastor and Youth Ministry Team to establish a comprehensive youth ministry that connects youth with other areas of ministry in the church, helps them grow in their faith, and keeps them connected with other generations of people in the church. Specifically, the youth ministry should help young people grow in their understanding of and practice of outreach, bible study, prayer and worship.
- Recruit, equip, empower and encourage youth ministry volunteers
- Lead YDOC meetings with help from youth ministry volunteers
- Teach Sunday School and/or provide for the training of Sunday School teacher(s)
- Coordinate events such as mission trips or camping/retreat experiences
- Equip and lead the youth to reach out to non-Christian youth and youth who have no church home
- Be an active part of the life of Fredericksburg Presbyterian Church
- Submit and manage the budget for the youth ministry

- Supervise and ensure the safety of youth at youth ministry functions
