Belize Mission 2013

The proposed goal of the 2013 mission is two fold, build a sustainable library for the San Narcisso Roman Catholic School and reconstruct an existing building as a kitchenette for the kindergarten classes. The library portion of the mission will be largely a US mission group's responsibility; the kitchenette will be constructed by the Belizean people funded by our mission efforts.

Library Building

\$10,000.00 USD

The Library building will be a prefabricated 24 X 24 wood structure built by the Mennonite Community in Shipyard, Belize and carried by truck to the site. Cost estimate include moving the structure. Additional materials for the library will be concrete pylons (that will need to exist before the building is moved into place) and slab material for shelving that will be installed during the 2013 mission. The build will come painted on the exterior.
