
Homework Center

We have an open door policy. Anyone can drop in after signing in with the Homework Center Coordinator. A homework assistance staff is backed up by the Youth Services Librarian.

Services Include:

- Homework help and guidance
- Help with writing assignments or school projects
- Computer resources including Internet and Database services
- Grade 1-8 curriculum support

Please be aware that this is not an alternative to after school day care or babysitting services. The Center's purpose is to assist children with their school work only. Students are expected to be respectful and considerate of those working around them. When students are finished, they must be picked up.
