

2011 Board of Directors Code of Conduct

1. Maintain the highest standards of professionalism, ethics and integrity in business, civic and personal activities.
2. Commit to offering the highest quality products & services.
3. Strive to assure complete satisfaction of all customers.
4. Honor all career and chamber commitments and be dedicated to enhancing the image and knowledge of community, business and chamber.
5. A board member must support, promote and enhance/embrace the membership, policies, programs and activities of the chamber.
6. Board members will be recruited only from current Chamber members who have a minimum of six months of active membership. Individual candidates must exhibit **personal active membership** – i.e. even though a company/business may have been a chamber member for six months/one year, if the individual candidate for board membership has not exhibited **personal involvement** in chamber activities, committees, luncheons, etc., then they still would not qualify to be nominated for a board position. We are looking for committed board members and the best way to anticipate commitment from nominated board members is to look at their “history” with the chamber.
7. Submit a written application agreeing to
 - a. Attending as many board meetings as possible (can’t miss three in a row)
 - b. Getting involved with at least one task/committee per year
 - c. Strive to attend the majority of events, luncheons, dinners etc.
 - d. Promote the chamber at all times and actively recruit new members as the opportunity arises.
 - e. Support all board decisions and support in a unified fashion
 - f. Agree to one or two consecutive terms
