### Board Positions for 2013

<b>President</b>	<b>Vince Vincent</b>	Vince has been an LPR member for 14 years. He is interested in running for President because, as he states, "I will provide leadership for the club that reemphasizes and promotes the "Good Time Region" mantra. I will work to create a team-pride association of the Board members and Chairpersons to promote the most value for the entire membership. <b>Laurie Delimon and Pam Ryder</b>	Combining their creative juices and marketing expertise, these two ladies spent incalculable hours redesigning the Prieta Post into an electronic format, helping pave the way for other PCA clubs to follow. Now the Post can easily be read on PCs, smart phones and tablets! The new e-Post, a key element in LPR's partner marketing program, helped increase advertising revenue to more than \$9,000, about three times what it was in prior years. In the first eight months of 2012, subscriptions to the e-Post grew by over 100, further increasing the exposure and value provided to our advertising partners. The e-Post covers a broad range of relevant topics, highlighting the many events LPR puts on as well as interesting articles on a wide variety of Porsche subjects. These two professionals volunteer countless hours each month gathering articles, columns and event announcements; writing and editing content; selecting, creating and posting photo albums and producing each month's layout. This is done not only for the monthly Prieta Post but also for the mid-month Activity Reminder, which was developed and introduced by this year's Post Editors to keep our membership informed of all upcoming LPR events. Pam and Laurie are both members of LPR's Marketing Committee.
<b>Anne Roth and Larry Sharp</b>	Anne and Larry teamed up this year and organized another superb Autocross season. Getting the best AX dates at Marina is no easy task. Anne ensures that we get our selection by staying up to submit our request at the midnight registration start so that we get first choice! The two kicked off the season with a well-attended informational AX Ground School designed to make the "newbies" more comfortable. Once the season began, Anne and Larry managed an entire team of volunteers who prepped the trailer, towed the trailer, designed the courses, registered the participants, organized lunches, staffed the track and maintained the stats. They continually execute a "hot cross over" which means more runs for the racers, while running a tight ship to ensure the safety of all participants. LPR AXs attract drivers from many Zone 7 regions with some coming as far as the Central Coast Region in Zone 8. Besides being a successful race program, AX is also a financial success for LPR adding considerably to our bottom line. The result is THE best AX program in the area.
