About the MEDC IPAD3 Raffle:

This is our 3rd year selling raffle tickets:



What is it for:

It is for the MEDC, which is a non for profit that serves the Village of

Montgomery and the business community.

What do you use the money for? It is used to help fund the MEDC with marketing funds to market the MEDC and the Village of Montgomery:

Why are the tickets numbered? They are numbered for tracking purposes. It helps distribution, counting and accountability.

Can I mix up the numbers? You sure can. You're welcome to sell them however you choose.

What happens if I cannot sell them all? Not a problem: We will accept all stubs with the cash all the way up until the day of the event. Even right before the drawing:

Can I come to the Party? You sure can. In fact, we encourage all participants to come and get to know the business community leaders, board members (both MEDC and GMACC) and many elected officials. Food comes from the local restaurants in the area and the list continues to grow each year.

What if I run out of tickets? Just call me, and I will be happy to deliver more:

What do I get out of selling these tickets for you? Last year, I had several small business owners who could not afford to purchase tickets. However, for every 4 tickets they sold, they added one in their name. Tickets are \$5.00 apiece, or 5 for \$20.00. You can earn one ticket for every four you sell.

Publicity: All vendors and business owners who display and/or sell the tickets will be mentioned in every email, eblast and press release, until the day of the event.

Am I responsible for these tickets? You are only responsible to turn them in to the people who purchased them from you. If you do not turn them in, (their stubs) or you keep the money or if they are stolen/lost then the people who purchased them from you, do not get a chance to win the IPAD3. If you're concerned about holding onto the stubs and the cash, just call me and I will come get them. My first year, a local bar owner called me weekly to replenish and pick up her stubs. How many tickets do you sell? 1500 tickets are printed but we average selling about 200-350 tickets, and making a little over \$1,000 each year.
