Dear Members and Friends:

You will find enclosed information about our Stewardship/Generosity Campaign for 2012. I hope you will take the time to read through the packet, gain understanding about our philosophy on giving, and prayerfully consider your response for this next year.

I know that this is a unpopular subject among church-goers, but it doesn't have to be. Our focus is on becoming the church that God has called us to be - to give our heart, mind, and strength fully to him, and to be willing to act sacrificially toward that calling. When we are obedient and faithful, God takes our little sacrifices and does more with them than we could ever hope or imagine.

I am asking that you move beyond simply doing what you've always done, and seek God's calling for you in this area for 2012. Those actions will not help you in your walk with Christ, and surely will not help our church in our attempts to move forward as a fruitful congregation. Please pray. Please be honest with yourself and with God. Please take a fresh look at your commitment to Christ. Finally, please take a step toward being obedient to God's will. If we will each do this - what more can we ask?

Thank you for your support of First United Methodist Church. Thank you for your prayers and your faith. I believe we can experience a great movement of the Spirit of Christ in our church in the coming months..., but it starts here. I hope you will join us in the journey and be willing to join us in the adventure of faith.
