Reporting to the Dean of the Medical School and Executive Vice President, the successful candidate will be an innovative leader and accomplished administrator who has a deep understanding of medical education and the changing health care landscape locally, regionally and nationally.

MCW a private, standalone institution, located on a park-like 240-acre Milwaukee Regional Medical Center campus, is ranked 42<sup>nd</sup> among medical schools nationwide for NIH funding. Administratively they will oversee the Office of Academic Affairs, which is comprised of approximately 48 FTE's and has a \$6 million budget, and includes Admissions, Academic Support Services, Curriculum, Student Affairs/Diversity, Registrar, Student Affairs, Student Financial Aid, Student Support Services and Continuing Professional Education. This individual also may be involved in teaching, research and/or clinical service in his/her area of specialization.
