

Hartford, CT - The Institute of Living (IOL), one of the nation's leading mental health centers, seeks an outstanding leader as **Medical Director**.

Founded in 1822, the IOL was one of the first mental health facilities in the country. Its 35-acre campus, landscaped by Frederick Law Olmsted, is a testament to its historic prominence. Today, as a division of Hartford Hospital (a component of the Hartford Healthcare system), the IOL provides a wide range of clinical services at all levels of care and numerous specialty programs. IOL researchers conduct leading studies in neuroimaging, genetics, personalized medicine, psychotherapies, clinical trials, outcome studies and other areas and generate significant NIH funding annually. Education is an important component of the IOL's mission with training programs in psychiatry, psychology, social work, nursing and rehabilitation.

Reporting to the Psychiatrist in Chief IOL/Vice President of Behavioral Health, Hartford Hospital and in collaboration with the Director of Clinical Operations and the Director of Nursing, the Medical Director oversees day to day management of the clinical operations of the IOL and is responsible for the quality of care in all clinical services. The Medical Director also works closely with the residency directors to facilitate the integration of the training programs with the delivery of clinical care.

The successful candidate will be an outstanding clinician with demonstrated leadership ability and strong administrative, interpersonal and communication skills. He/she should demonstrate an understanding of the importance of clinical outcomes, investigation, and teaching in a patient driven service culture. Candidates will be board certified in psychiatry, and have a track record of professional accomplishment sufficient to be eligible for an appointment at the University of Connecticut School of Medicine. Outstanding research, and/or teaching credentials will enhance candidacy.
