The Medical College of Wisconsin (MCW) invites applications and nominations for the positions of the Campus Deans in Wausau and Green Bay, Wisconsin. Reporting to the Dean of the Medical School/Executive Vice President of MCW, the successful candidates will be innovative leaders and excellent collaborators who bring a deep understanding of medical education, particularly regional medical education within community settings, and the changing health care landscape.

MCW a private, standalone institution, located on a park-like 240-acre Milwaukee Regional Medical Center campus, is ranked 42nd among medical schools nationwide for NIH funding. MCW has made a commitment to developing a community medical education program that both addresses the need for providers in underserved communities across Wisconsin and employs an immersive teaching model that will reduce student debt and allow students quicker entry into practice. This immersive teaching model will allow medical students to receive their education and training in Green Bay or Central Wisconsin, with a goal that the students remain in surrounding communities to practice. In June 2012, MCW selected Green Bay and Central Wisconsin as locations for the first two community medical education program campuses. The goal is to admit the first group of 15 medical students to at least one of the new campuses as early as July 2015.

Collaborating closely with community physician practices, county medical societies, academic and health system leaders, local government, and business and civic leaders, and the leadership at MCW, the Campus Deans in Green Bay and Central Wisconsin will play a leading role in defining and formalizing all aspects of the community medical campus including the physical infrastructure, the academic, and the administrative components at each site. The selected Campus Deans will have proven experience working with communities and community medical organizations, hospital and academic institutional leaders, and a distinguished academic and professional career, including significant teaching, research and/or clinical experience. Candidates should hold an MD degree and the academic rank of associate or full professor is expected. PhDs or other advanced degrees will also be considered.
