

## **OB/GYN Maternal Fetal Medicine Division Director**

The OB/GYN Department has 24 faculty members and over 140 private attendings across all Gynecological and Obstetrical specialties. The OB/GYN Department has an accredited residency program with 6 residents per year and approximately 7000 women per year deliver at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center, a large proportion of whom have high risk pregnancies. The MFM Division has six faculty members and an accredited MFM Fellowship Program. The Division Director will lead and collaborate with other faculty and private attending as a means to maintain academic standards of excellence and carry out the program's vision.

The Division Director must demonstrate excellence in teaching, research and maternal fetal medicine. Evidence of academic productivity in clinical research and well established expertise in prenatal ultrasonography are strongly preferred.

The candidate should have an established academic career in maternal fetal medicine with a minimum of eight (8) years experience since completing fellowship and must be board-certified in Maternal Fetal Medicine. Leadership experience is required and candidate must have the ability to work cooperatively and collegially within a diverse environment. Must possess or be able to obtain a valid, non-restrictive California Medical License. The successful candidate must have a strong commitment to academic medicine. Faculty appointments are through the Cedars-Sinai Professorial Series and the David Geffen School of Medicine at University of California, Los Angeles in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology.

Primary responsibilities include: maintenance and expansion of a high risk obstetrical program; direction of the prenatal diagnostic center; leadership of the academic goals of the division; education of fellows, residents and medical students; maintenance of clinical MFM practice; and development of the MFM portion of the perinatal center.
