

**BERNARDS HIGH SCHOOL
2013 SENIOR PROM
Permission Form**

The Senior Class of Bernards High School will host the annual Senior Prom on the evening of ***Friday, June 7, 2013 from 7pm to 11pm at the Madison Hotel.***

The Prom will begin with hors d'oeuvres at 7:00pm, followed by dinner at 8:00pm. No one will be admitted to the Prom after 8:00pm. Students will not be allowed to leave until 10:00. Parents will be notified of students leaving before 10:00. Anyone who leaves The Prom prior to its conclusion without direct permission from Ms. Cerza will not be re-admitted.

The Prom is, by definition, is a **formal dance**. Attendance at this dance, or any other Bernards High School dance, is not required of any student. The Prom is sponsored by the Senior Class under the authority of the Somerset Hills Board of Education. Therefore, the Senior Class reserves the right to determine the theme and style of dress for this activity. **The style of dress is formal.**

Formal attire for men traditionally includes the following: dress shirt with collar, necktie or bow tie, tuxedo, suit, sport jacket, dress slacks, shoes, socks, etc. Formal attire for women traditionally includes the following: evening gown, dress, ladies' suit, skirt with blouse, scarf, etc. Certain formal attire may include a matching hat. In all situations, formal attire is clean, well-conditioned, matched, and dignified, coinciding with the formal tone of the event.

Formal attire does not include, for instance, such items as shorts, jeans, T-shirts, tank tops, sweat suits, overalls, sandals, sneakers, boots, hats, etc. Students may bring sneakers to the prom in which to change for dancing purposes only. If brought, the sneakers must be carried in open view – no bags or containers will be allowed into the prom.

Students attired inappropriately for the Senior Prom will not be admitted. In such unfortunate cases, no monies will be refunded. Questions regarding proper attire should be directed to the Senior Class Advisor, Ms. Cerza, well in advance of the event. Students who feel they cannot abide by the formal dress requirement for this event are encouraged not to attend. Such students are urged not to embarrass themselves and their guest by attempting to disregard or circumvent the dress requirement.
