Student Council elects five officers annually: **president, vice president, treasurer, recording secretary, and corresponding secretary.** Officers are elected in two steps:

1. Students running for office must complete a Petition for Office, which includes 20 student signature of endorsement and three faculty signature of endorsement.
2. When more than one student successfully completes a Petition for Office for the same position, an election will be held throughout the student body to choose between the candidates.
3. **Only** candidates for President will have a speech on the public address system on the election day.

All candidates should be aware of the requirements for being a Student Council officer. This includes attendance at Student Council meetings and events. Officers will be expected to set an example for other Student Council members and to take a leading role in planning and organizing Student Council events. **ALL campaign posters must be approved and initialed by Ms. Gray (A 408) prior to being displayed.** The posters can be displayed from April 8 to April 12 only!
