1. Students running for office must complete a Petition for Office, which includes 20 student signature of endorsement and three faculty signature of endorsement.
2. When more than one student successfully completes a Petition for Office for the same position, an election will be held throughout the student body to choose between the candidates.
3. Only candidates for President will have a speech on the public address system on the election day.

All candidates should be aware of the requirements for being a Student Council officer. This includes attendance at Student Council meetings and events. Officers will be expected to set an example for other Student Council members and to take a leading role in planning and organizing Student Council events. ALL campaign posters must be approved and initialed by Ms. Gray (A 408) prior to being displayed. The posters can be displayed from April 8 to April 12 only!
