The Prior Authorization of PMD Demonstration will require prior authorization for scooters and power wheelchairs (called power mobility devices) for all people with original Medicare who reside in seven states with high populations of fraud and error-prone providers (CA, IL, MI, NY, NC, FL, and TX). The demonstration will be implemented in two phases, effective January 1, 2012. During the first phase (the first three to nine months), the Medicare Administrative Contractors will conduct prepayment reviews on power mobility device claims. The second phase, for the remainder of this three-year demonstration, will implement prior authorization, a tool utilized by private-sector health care payers to prevent improper payments and deter fraud. Physicians and treating practitioners, working with their suppliers, will have to submit a prior authorization request for a device before the supplier can submit a claim to Medicare.

This meeting is open to Medicare providers and suppliers as well as provider associations, partner organizations, and other stakeholders. The purpose of this meeting is to educate audiences about the value of the PMD demonstration to the long-term security of Medicare by preventing fraud, waste, and abuse and reducing improper payments. Time will be allotted for questions. *Associations may invite member providers*.
