The Church Renewal Program offers a practical process to strengthen the quality of your church's essential ministries and reconnect with God's purpose for your congregation.

Vital, growing congregations know how their purpose is connected to God's purpose for the church. They believe that what they do brings hope and help to people's lives in the name of Christ.

How does this work? Each church recruits a leadership team made up of the pastor and at least three lay members. Everyone attends the Kick-Off Event on Saturday, October 15, 2011 for orientation to the basic concepts of church renewal.

Our text is *Five Practices of Fruitful Congregations*, which focuses on the five essential activities of church life. Your team will assess your church in these areas and create an action plan for strengthening your ministries:

- Radical hospitality
- Passionate worship
- Intentional faith development
- Risk-taking mission and service
- Extravagant generosity

Each leadership team will meet back home once a month for five months. The group works on one of the *Five Practices* themes each month guided by a trained leader.

At the Round up session on May 12, teams will get help creating their follow-up action plan.



### Your church will benefit from the church renewal program if it:

- Has plateaued or declining worship attendance for at least the past three years;
- Has resources of faith, leadership, and finances that make it possible to devote time to a new project;
- Is not experiencing serious conflict and has a pattern of healthy communication among members and leaders;
- Can put together a team of lay leaders who can envision a different future;
- Can commit to full participation in all seven sessions.

Cost: \$85.00 per person. This includes the book series, kick off event and a back home trainer. The trainer travel costs to your church are extra.
