Municipal Election – May 2013

The Municipal Election Commission of the Town of Sullivan's Island will conduct The Town of Sullivan's Island Municipal Election on Tuesday, May 7, 2013.

The following offices shall be included in this election.

One (1) Mayor Three (3) Council Members

Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the above listed offices may file at the Town Hall, 2050-B Middle Street, Sullivan's Island, SC 29482.

Books will be open for candidate filing, Friday, January 11, 2013, and remain open during regular business hours until Wednesday February 20, 2013. By Noon on Wednesday, February 20, 2013, all petition candidates must have their petitions and Statement of Economic Interest forms submitted to the Municipal Clerk of the Town of Sullivan's Island. The Petition must have signatures from at least five percent (5%) of registered voters from the geographical area covered by the office sought by the candidate.

Persons desiring to vote in the upcoming municipal election must be registered to vote no later than April 5, 2013 if registering in person, or the application must be postmarked no later than April 7, 2013 if it is being mailed to the County Board of Voter Registration office.

Absentee ballots may be requested and mailed from the Board of Elections and Voter Registration Office of Charleston County. Persons wishing to cast their absentee ballot in person at the Board of Elections and Voter Registration Office, 4367 Headquarters Rd., N. Charleston may do so until 5:00 pm on Monday, May 6, 2013. The examination of absentee ballot return envelopes will be held at the Sunrise Presbyterian Church at 7:00 p.m. on election day.

This is a nonpartisan election and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot.

The polling place for this district is Sunrise Presbyterian Church, 3322 Middle Street.

The polls shall open at 7:00 a.m. on election day, and close at 7:00 p.m.

On Thursday, May 9, 2013, at 12:00 noon at the Town Hall of Sullivan's Island, the Municipal Election Commission will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election.

Any run-off, if needed, will be held two weeks after the election on Tuesday, May 21, 2013.
