Household Garbage: December 26<sup>th</sup> & January 2<sup>nd</sup> (Wednesdays)

**Yard/Bulk Trash**: December 27<sup>th</sup> & January 3<sup>rd</sup> (Thursdays)

**Recycling**: December 27<sup>th</sup> (Thursday)

\*Roll-out carts curbside by 7AM on collection day and removed by 7PM.

## 2013 Licenses & Permits

Renew your dog permit for 2013 (sold starting Monday, December 3<sup>rd</sup>).

Permits issued Mon-Fri (8AM-5PM) at Town Hall (2050-B Middle Street -behind Fire Station).

Remember to bring your current rabies vaccination record (need to provide a hard copy every year), check/cash payment (\$35/permit; resident rate is \$25/permit) and name of liability insurance carrier (i.e. homeowner's or renter's insurance).

## HOLIDAY SAFETY TIPS

Shopping: Remember to lock your vehicle, have your keys ready when you leave a store for the parking lot, stow your purchases in your locked trunk but do not store your gifts in the trunk for the whole season. Use general safety measures when shopping – try to shop with a friend or avoid dark parking lots at night.

**Identity Protection:** This year, more than ever, be mindful of your credit and debit cards, checks and cash. Be careful when entering your PIN at stores, and ensure the cashier asks you for identification with non-cash transactions (the stores should already use this procedure.

House watch: If travelling, take advantage of the Police Department House Watch. Contact PD (843) 883-5740 or Town Hall (843) 883-3198 to sign up. Give the impression the house is occupied: suspend newspaper/mail delivery and put lights on timers, or, have a neighbor/friend do this for you.
