 program, instruct on Model UN Rules of Procedure, and assist students with skill building
 (research, resolution writing, public speaking, negotiation, etc.);
- Assist with UNA-MN Global Classrooms Model UN Conferences throughout the school year;
- Work closely with the Global Classrooms Program Coordinator and Associate to carry out program initiatives;
- Attend Professional Development workshops designed for *Global Classrooms* teachers;
- Assist with other projects as assigned.

- Be currently enrolled as a college student in the St. Paul / Minneapolis area;
