Lay Servant Ministries

<u>NOTE</u>: The 2012 UMC General Conference changed Local Lay Speaker and Certified Lay Speaker to Local Church Lay Servant and Certified Lay Servant respectively; it also "reestablished" Certified Lay Speaker as a distinct recognition within Lay Servant Ministries.

What is a Lay Servant?

(Book of Discipline, ¶ 266)

A lay servant is a professing member of a local church or charge who is ready and desirous to serve the Church and who is well informed on and committed to the Scriptures and the doctrine, heritage, organization, and life of The United Methodist Church and who has received specific training to develop skills in witnessing to the Christian faith through spoken communication. church and communitv leadership, and care-giving ministries. An applicant must be active in the support of the local church or charge.

Must I be a Lay Servant or applying to become one to take a class?

<u>No!</u> All laity are welcome to take any class even if not applying to the Lay Servants program.

What is the difference between a <u>Local Church</u> and a <u>Certified</u> Lay Servant?

A Local Church Lay Servant serves their local church in which membership is held through ministries of leading, caring, and communicating. Certified Lay Servants continue to serve their local church through these ministries, but also may serve as class leaders, or in the district and conference and in other local churches. All Lav Servants must file a report with their Charge Conference every year. Local Church Lay Servants must retake a Basic Course equivalent every third year or an Annual Conference-approved substitute. Certified Lay Servants must take at least one advanced course every three years to maintain registered recognition.

Basic Lay Servant Course

This basic course is the foundation for other texts in the *Learning and Leading* series for Lay Servants. In this Basic Course, individuals are encouraged to recognize and employ personal spiritual gifts for the Church in order to use them as God fully intended. Completion of this course is a prerequisite to recognition as either a Local Church Lay Servant or Certified Lay Servant and is also a required step for those seeking eventual recognition as Certified Lay Speakers.
