How do I know if I'm eligible?

- ◆ Applicants must have completed at least one semester as a full-time student at JCJC.
- ◆ Applicants must be currently enrolled as a full-time student and must have a 2.5 or higher cumulative grade point average (GPA).
- ◆ Applicants must be planning to attend JCJC as a full-time student for the upcoming academic year (Fall 2013 and Spring 2014).
- ◆ Previous scholarship recipients need to reapply each year.

Tips for Completing Your JCJC Foundation Scholarship Application

- ◆ Neatness does count. Use proper capitalization and punctuation.
- ◆ Be sure to complete all phases of your application process. In the last phase, we urge you to apply for as many scholarships as possible. This assures that you have a better chance of receiving a scholarship. **Make sure the application is received by April 1, 2013 for consideration.**
