

Spring Shredding!

Saturday, April 30th, from 9am until 1pm

About Sergeant Shredder: Their employees undergo a 7 year background check, and they are FACTA and HIPAA Compliant. You may even receive a Certificate of Destruction (for example, if your licensing agency requires this of you) at the end of your shredding session. You may bring up to 5 boxes (so more people can benefit) of paperwork that you need to shred. You may bring your documents to the school and you will see their truck parked near the flag pole. They do not drive off with highly sensitive and critical personal information (like account numbers, addresses and social security numbers); they remain onsite until everything is shredded. Additionally, for your assurance, their truck has a video monitor so that you may stand outside the truck and watch your documents being shredded inside. Nice! Another advantage is that they recycle the paper pulp that they generate. This is where the fund raising comes in for WSOC. They sell this pulp as a commodity, and they will split the proceeds with us 50/50. Guidelines for what **you may shred**: any paper, any color; any paper with staples, paper clips, rubber bands or binder clips and file folders of any color. **Materials that should never be shredded** are: wet trash, aluminum cans, food products or hazardous materials.
