NEW CLERGY GROUPS

for clergy in their first three years of ministry, meet monthly in small groups of three to five, assisted by a more

experienced pastor who is trained to serve as facilitator and mentor.

Here, new pastors find the support and guidance they need to navigate the transition from seminary into pastoral ministry. They will learn best practices for meeting the challenges of the first years of ministry and developing habits that will enable them to thrive for a lifetime of effective service.

CLERGY COMMUNITIES OF PRACTICE offer more experienced pastors opportunities to hone their practices of ministry and develop meaningful collegial friendships.

Counteracting the risks of isolation and burnout, the Clergy Communities of Practice are designed to help clergy uncover the challenges of ministry and the possibilities of new growth.

CONTINUING EDUCATION AND LEARNING EVENTS: Conference-wide learning events widen the circle of conversation beyond the clergy groups. Colloquies also offer opportunities for focused learning and discussion on particular topics. An annual series for graduating seminarians helps to equip them for the search and call process.

Debbie Clark, who has served as Pastor of Edwards Church, in Framingham for fifteen years, said, "It's always hard to get in the car and set aside time for another meeting, because there are other things that need to be done. But participating in a Clergy Community of Practice, which is a cornerstone of the MACUCC's Pastoral Excellence Program, has been an investment in building those relationships that are going to be there for me when I need them, and ultimately, for my church."

Debbie now facilitates a Community of Practice group, recalls, "A member of our church council came up to me and said, 'this is one of the best things we can be supporting.' The fact that she had grown up in this church and was excited about the program – that she
