**To date** we have gently tied these ribbons between UU congregations, humanist groups, and Hispanic communities

- 380 "Banned Books" and 30 children's titles SmUUggled to the Phoenix General Assembly, and donated to the Puente Community Center Library
- Nearly 50 additional Banned Books donated to start a Community based library in El Paso
- 40 textbooks sent to Tucson youngsters studying Chican@ Literature in an alternate course at the Valenzuela Youth Center
- 20 humanist and/or UU sponsored events (speakers, readings, displays, poetry) held across the country in September

#### **Future Activities**

- Between now and the end of 2012: purchase and send to Hispanic community libraries an additional 200 titles, for adults and children
- At the 2013 General Assembly in Louisville, create a new community lending library, and display and parade a "Living Ribbon" – folks holding many fabric panels, reflecting the themes of some of the Tucson banned books, and celebrating other aspects of Hispanic-American culture.
